From the Pastor..

Dear Christ Lutheran members and friends, How have you been doing during our very odd winter season which is starting to come to a close? I am sure we will have another winter storm from now until mid-April (hopefully not!) - but spring is coming as we turn our clocks ahead an hour on March 10th and spring occurs officially on the 19th. This reminds me of 'Spring Cleaning' and cleaning out stuff in our house and our garage (if you have one) along with reflecting upon our lives and trying to figure out where our lives are at. This is a great time to do this during the Lenten season, as this is a season of reflection and preparation awaiting Easter Sunday.

During this Lenten season as we reflect upon our lives and prepare for Easter, which is on March 31st, this is a great time to see where our life is going today, in the next few months, and throughout this 2024 year? Do you have 'stuff' you still have in your closet that you know you should be getting rid of yet you keep it for some reason? Have you ever asked yourself, 'Why do I keep it?' or do you say to yourself, 'One day I'll need that 1970s checked pair of pants?'

With all humor aside, this brings me to our 'Spiritual Life'. These past few months our church has been studying from a book called, *Messy Spirituality - God's Annoying Love for Imperfect People.* Back on February 21st - for our 1st Wednesday of Lent - I spoke about this book and want to share a few thoughts for you to ponder this month.

A few weeks ago we were discussing Chapter 2 titled - *The Place Where Are Messiness and Jesus Meet.* The author, Michael Yaconelli, stated that spiritual people admit that they are unfinished - incomplete - imperfect - - in progress - and 'Under Construction'

He said, 'Spiritual describes someone who is incomplete, imperfectly living their life for God. The 'Construction Site' of our souls exposes our flaws and our self-doubt in ourselves.' When we seek God - Jesus begins to take shape in our lives. He begins good work in us - but the finishing process is a more-than-a-lifetime process. The work of God in our lives will never be finished' -Mike said - '...until we meet Jesus face-to-face'. The author of Hebrews - wrote, 'Let us fix our eyes on Jesus - the author - the perfector - (our finisher) of our faith.'

In other words, 'Spirituality isn't about being finished and perfect - spirituality is about trusting God in our unfinishedness.' We are constantly cleaning our spiritual closets out and being renewed each day. Maybe, today, you feel unqualified to call yourself a Christian because of your 'closet', your background, and because of your mistakes - but it is truly amazing how God can use the most unqualified in life like you and me to continue to build up God's kingdom.

It's amazing how few of us believe in the unqualified grace of God. Oh yes God loves us - as we are all 'Under Construction' when it comes to our 'Spiritual Life' - yet Jesus is constantly fixing us up for His Majesty when we meet Him in all of His Glory - someday. Jesus loves every one of us! He is the one who made us who we are today. He has plans for each of us regardless if we are 1 or 100 years old!

Minutes from 12/27/2023 (January)

Topics Discussed

Jim Jens reported that he received rough bids for doors that need replacement on each side of the alter area and the chapel lounge. Side doors will cost approximately \$3,500 each (includes new jams, threshold, hardware, etc.) and the chapel door is larger and will cost \$4,000 to \$4,500. He stated that the chapel lounge door is in poor condition and needs to be replaced soon before replacing the other two doors. No work will be done without council approval.

Jeff reported that bids from Peschkes tree service for trimming two maple trees at the parsonage have been received. Cost is \$350 per tree or \$700 total. Approval from the church council is required to approve the bid. This was the final board meeting for Jim Jens & Denny Lickness. The board thanked them both for their service. As per the church constitution the Property & Management Board is responsible for developing the annual budget. Curt Jensen will meet with Gail Radke (treasurer), Sue Blackmer (president), and Bobbi (office manager) to formulate a budget for 2024. The meeting was adjourned and Curt Jensen will report


